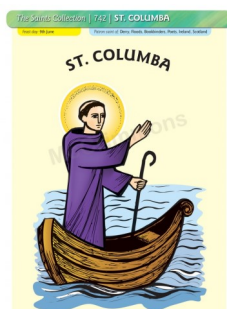

St. Columba

(born c. 521, Gartan [in County Donegal, Ireland]—died June 8/9, 597, Iona [Inner [Hebrides](#), Scotland]; feast day June 9) is an Irish [saint](#) who is credited with having had a main role in the conversion of [Scotland](#) to [Christianity](#) in the 6th century. He is a [patron saint](#) of Scotland and one of the three patron saints of [Ireland](#), along with [St. Patrick](#) and [St. Brigid](#). He is also revered as the patron of the city of [Derry](#), Northern Ireland; poets; and bookbinders and is [invoked](#) against [floods](#). Columba and his associates and successors spread the [gospel](#) more than any other contemporary group of religious pioneers in [Britain](#).

Columba is believed to have been born in the civil parish of Gartan in what is now [County Donegal](#), in the northwest of Ireland. Folk tradition states that he was born on December 7, 521, and that this was a Thursday (a day associated with luck in Scottish [folklore](#)), though many of the details of his birth have been contested by scholars. He is believed to have been the son of noble parents and a descendant of Niall of the Nine Hostages, who founded the great Uí Néill [dynasty](#) in the 4th century. His [baptismal](#) name, Colum, comes from *columba*, the [Latin](#) word for [dove](#). His [Irish](#) name, Colm Cille, means “dove of the church.”
