

## St. Columba

(born c. 521, Gartan [in County Donegal, Ireland]—died June 8/9, 597, Iona [Inner Hebrides, Scotland]; feast day June 9) is an Irish saint who is credited with having had a main role in the conversion of Scotland to Christianity in the 6th century. He is a patron saint of Scotland and one of the three patron saints of Ireland, along with St. Patrick and St. Brigid. He is also revered as the patron of the city of Derry, Northern Ireland; poets; and bookbinders and is invoked against floods. Columba and his associates and successors spread the gospel more than any other contemporary group of religious pioneers in Britain.

Columba is believed to have been born in the civil parish of Gartan in what is now County Donegal, in the northwest of Ireland. Folk tradition states that he was born on December 7, 521, and that this was a Thursday (a day associated with luck in Scottish folklore), though many of the details of his birth have been contested by scholars. He is believed to have been the son of noble parents and a descendant of Niall of the Nine Hostages, who founded the great Uí Néill dynasty in the 4th century. His baptismal name, Colum, comes from columba, the Latin word for dove. His Irish name, Colm Cille, means "dove of the church."
