
THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD 12TH JANUARY 2025

READINGS Year C

First Reading: Isaiah 40:1-5. 9-11 Psalm: Ps.103:1-4.24-25.27-30 Second Reading: Titus2:11-14:3. 4-7 Gospel: Luke 3:15-16.21-22

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord in the Catholic tradition commemorates the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist¹. It signifies the end of the Christmas season and marks the beginning of Jesus' ministry and confirms his identity as the Son of God². The event is documented in all the gospels except John². The feast invites reflection on the mystery of our own baptism³.

In Baptism we have turned from the old life of sin to a new life in Jesus Christ. It means we are publicly identifying with <u>Christ's death</u>, burial, and <u>resurrection</u>. It means we are openly joining the ranks of those who believe in Christ.
